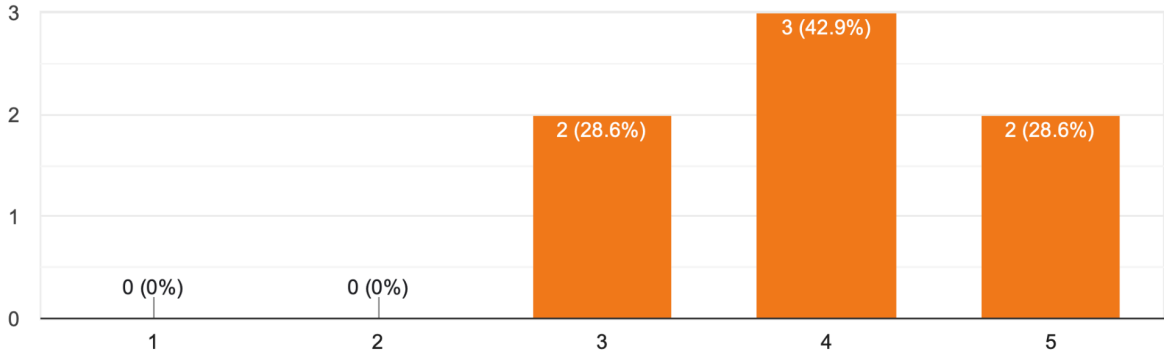

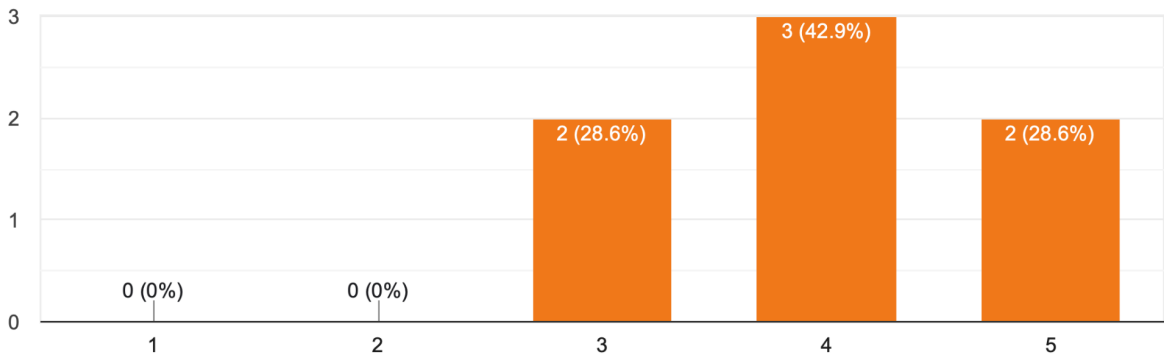
The board consistently makes decisions that align with STRIDE Academy's mission and purpose.

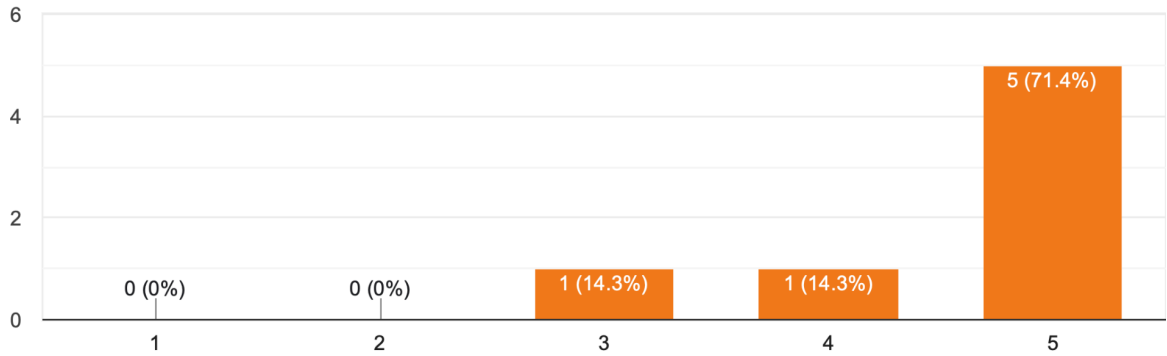
The board understands and fulfills its responsibilities related to the charter contract and authorizer expectations.

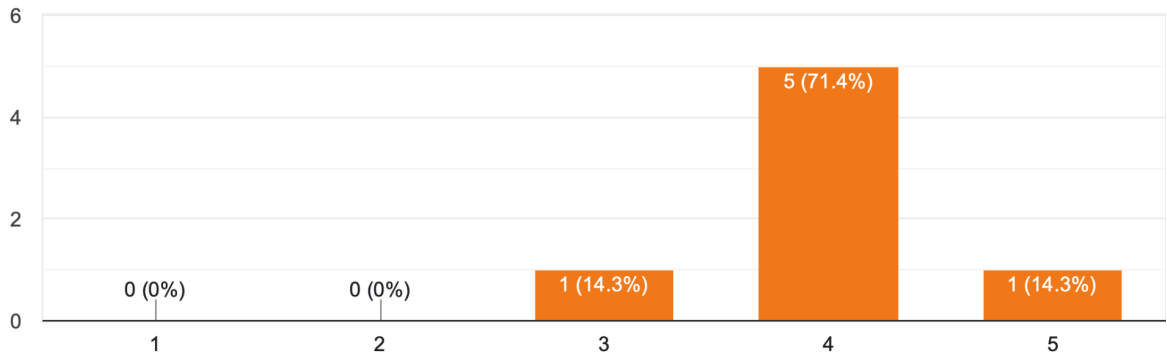
The board ensures strong financial oversight and long-term fiscal sustainability.

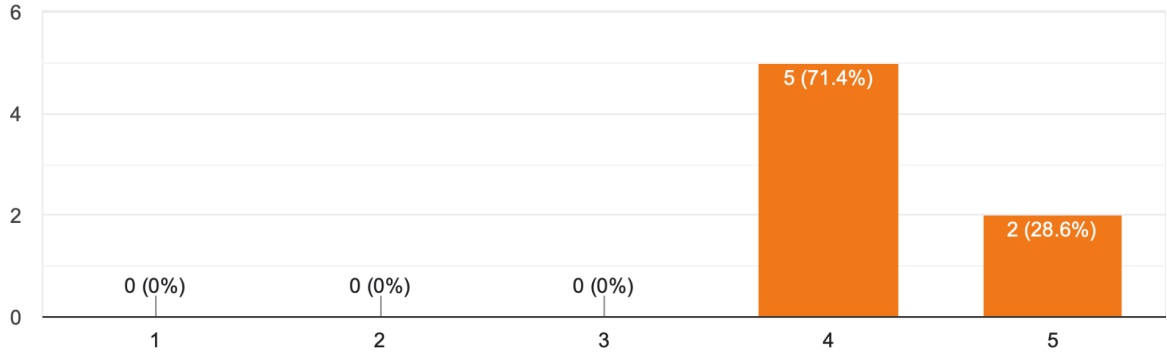
The board maintains appropriate boundaries between governance (oversight/policy) and management (day-to-day operations).

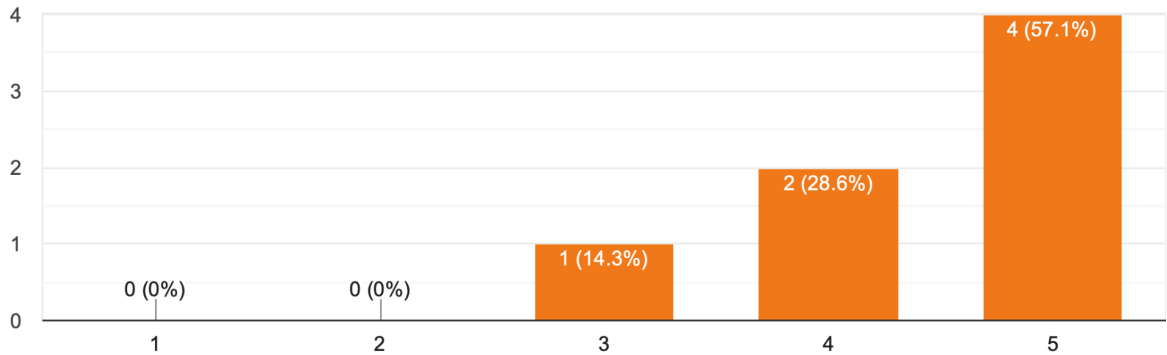
The board establishes and regularly reviews policies to ensure legal compliance and effective operations.

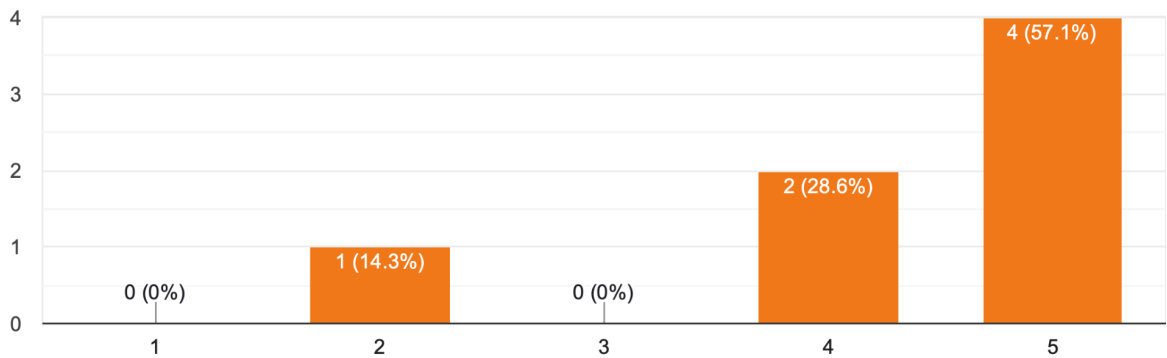

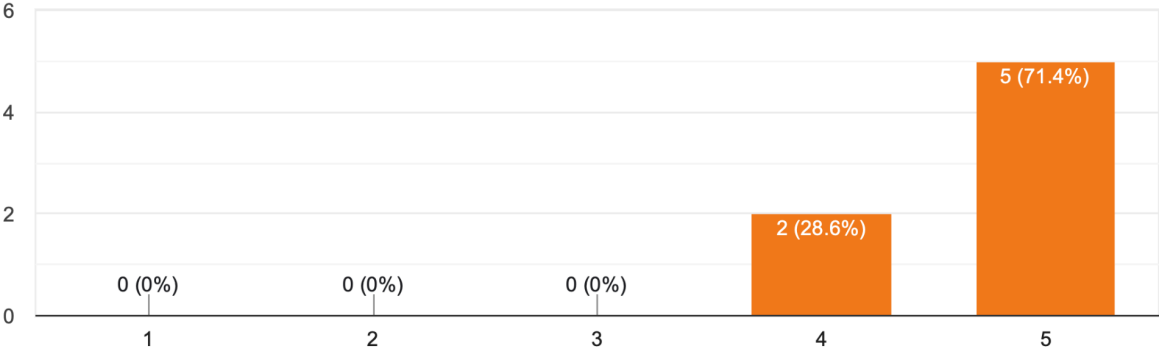

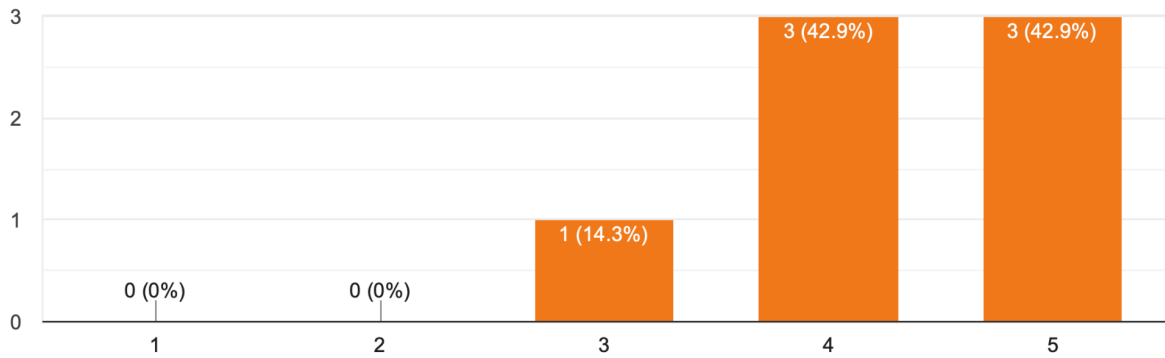
The board operates with transparency and adheres to open meeting law and ethical standards.
