- 246 EL students K-7th grades
 (Last year 178 EL students K-6 grades)
 - 3 EL teachers and one literacy teacher
 - 48% of our school is EL

EL classes are pull out model

First Grade

Two teachers (EL and literacy) take five or six EL students for half an hour and then switch groups. We work on concepts/words from Journeys in a smaller setting. Students see us every other day for an hour.

Second Grade

Two EL teachers take four groups of six students for an hour every other day. Reading and writing are practiced.

Third grade

Three EL teachers take four groups of students for one hour a day. One EL teacher does writing for half an hour, the other does guided reading for half an hour, and the other teacher does IRead on the chromebooks as well as vocabulary work.

Fourth grade

Two EL teachers take groups of students for half an hour each and switch during the language arts block. One teacher does guided reading, and the other teacher does vocabulary work and writing.

Fifth, Sixth, Seventh grades

One EL teacher pulls groups of students during language arts and works in small groups.

 We have a newcomer group for Spanish speakers for half an hour taught by two EL teachers.

 One EL teacher as well as the literacy teacher do Foundations one on one with first grade students on a three day rotation in the morning.
