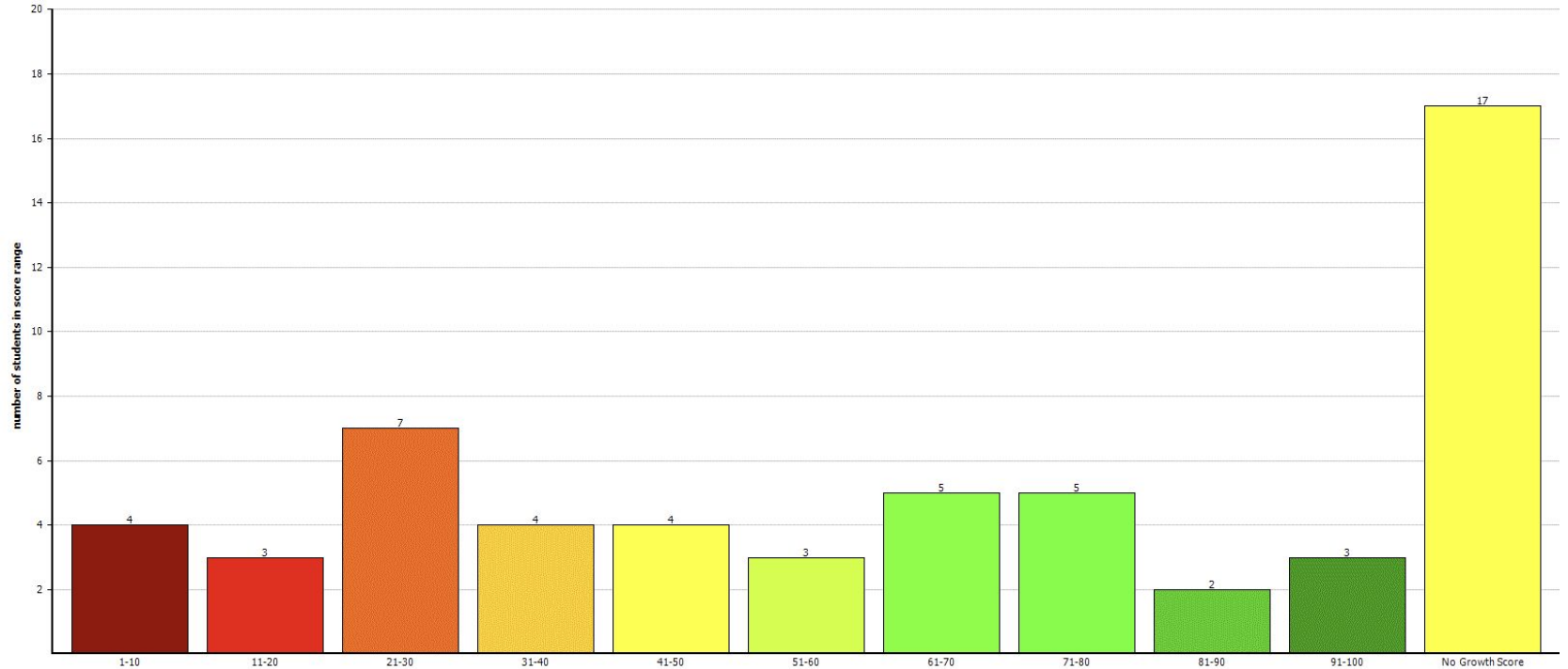
Growth by Percentile (66 students)





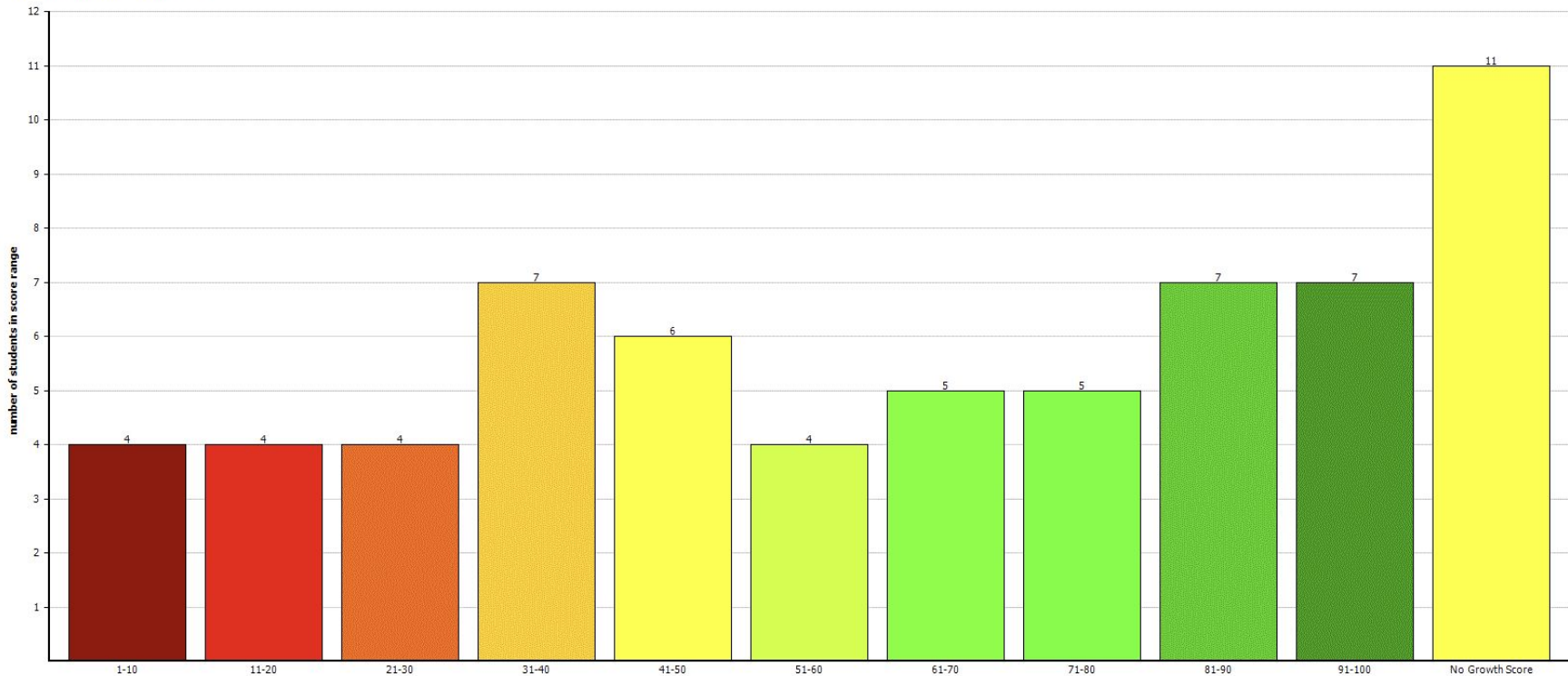
